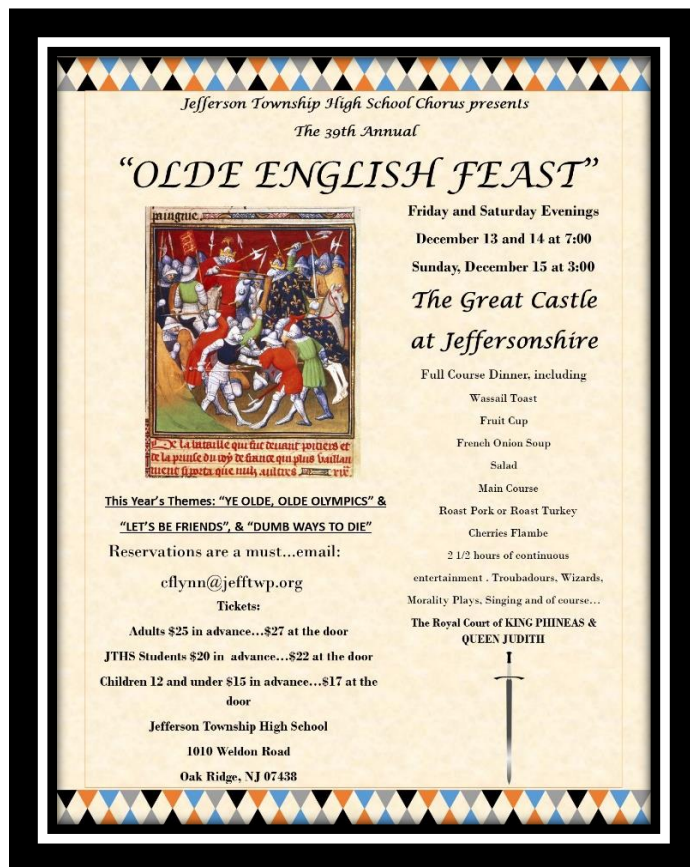
## Murder's in the Heir –

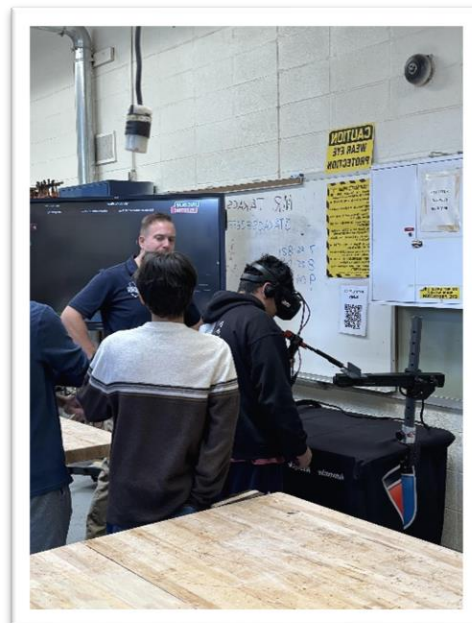

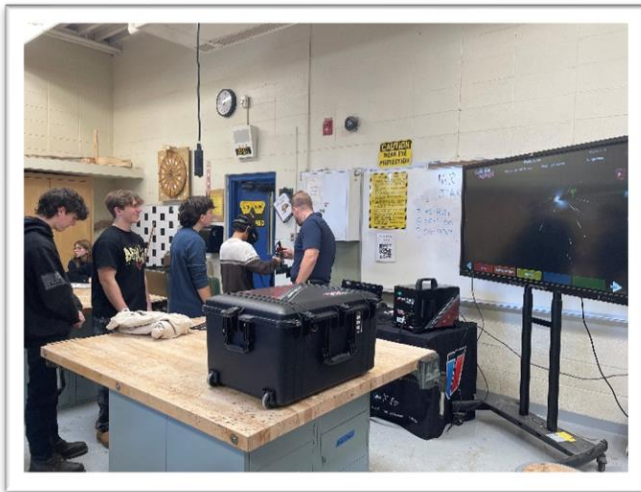
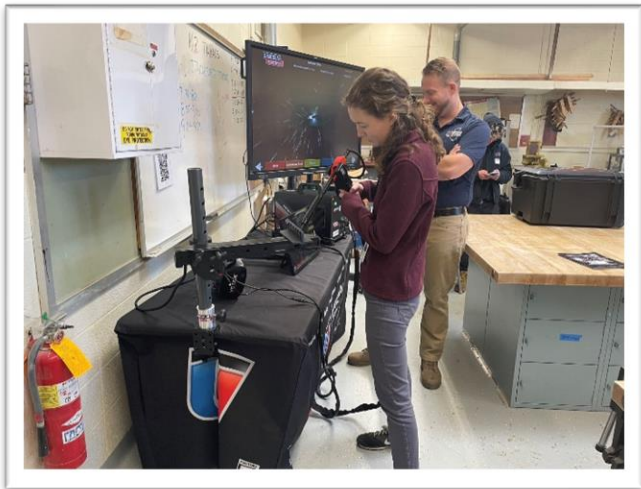
## Technology Education Class –
