NJ ABLE ACCOUNTS

ABLE is a 529A tax-advantaged savings program for persons with a disability, which allows for saving money for qualified disability expenses, tax-free <u>AND</u> allows for saving beyond current asset limits and still maintain eligibility for many means-tested government benefits, namely Medicaid, SSI, and HUD benefits
